



# About the TRETYAKOV GALLERY




- The Tretyakov Gallery in Moscow, one of the world's largest museums of fine art, enjoys a truly universal popularity in Russian. The Gallery was founded in 1860 and was reconstructed in 1901.



# About PAVEL TRETYAKOV

PAVEL TRETYAKOV and his brother Sergey were Russian merchants. He decided to found a national gallery for Russian people. It was in 1860. TRETYAKOV was very strict in selecting pictures. TRETYAKOV was very careful in choosing the place for his picture for them not loose their beauty.



# Portrait of ALEXANDER PUSHKIN (1827)



**Kiprensky** painted his portrait of Pushkin after six-years stay in Italy. His return to Russia helped him to revive many of the fine qualities of his early works. At the same time this period proved to be rather trying: The liberal ideals which had inspired the artist in the opening decades of the nineteenth century were on the wane.



# THE RIDER (1832)

To **Briullov** Italy was the home of classical art, artists' promised land. There he spent the best years of his youth, completing his training upon graduation from St Petersburg Academy of Fine Arts. As well as several portraits in the grand manner, of which THE RIDER is one of the best.



# A GIRL WITH PEACHES (1887)



There is hardly another painting in Russian or, for the matter, in world art that arouses such radiant, happy feelings, or is so appealing and pleasing as GIRL WITH PEACHES.

# HEAD OF A BOY (1818)

**Tropinin** was one of the leading painters of the Moscow school in the first half of the nineteenth century. One has only to look at the easy postures, good-natured smiles and plain domestic clothes of Tropinin's models to get a feeling of the special character of Moscow's free and easy life.
