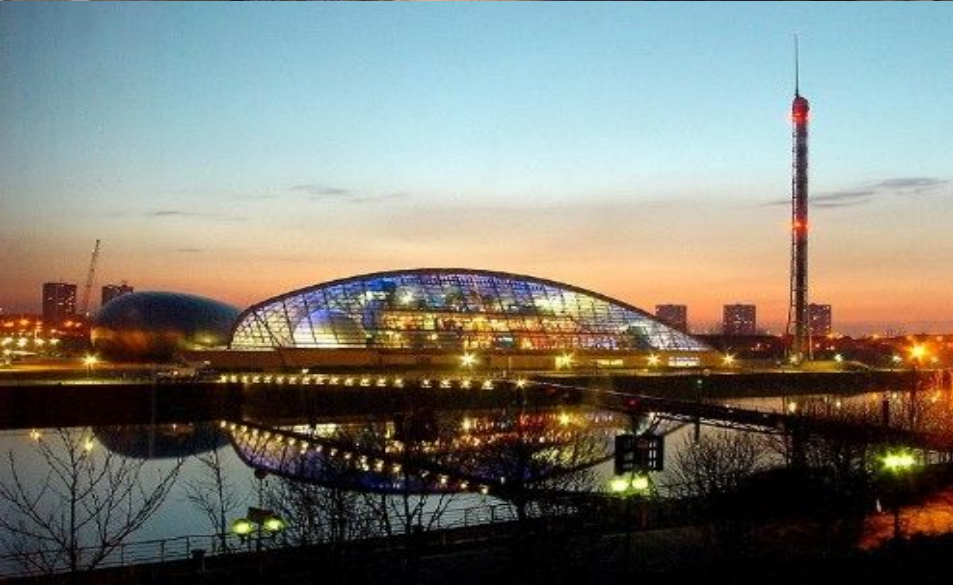

IT GREW FROM BEING A PLEASANT BURGH IN PRETTY COUNTRYSIDE INTO A GREAT CITY, STARTING FIRST IN THE 17TH CENTURY AS A MAJOR SEAPORT TO WHICH SUGAR AND TOBACCO WERE IMPORTED FROM AMERICA
