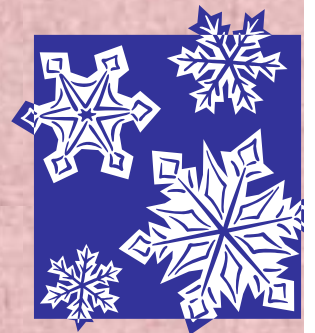
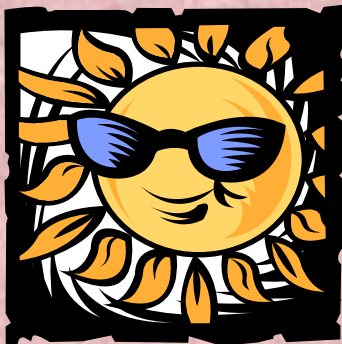

All day and all night.**

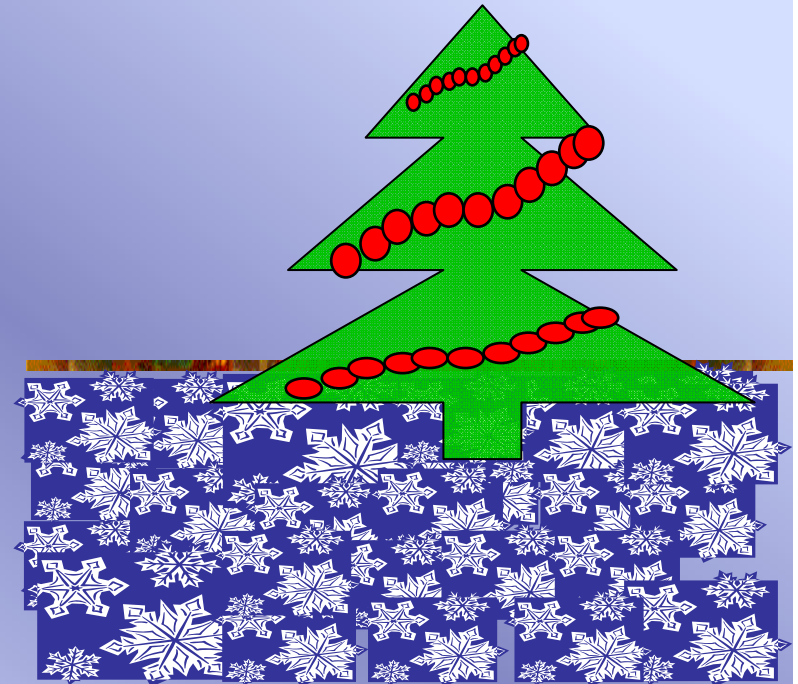




December

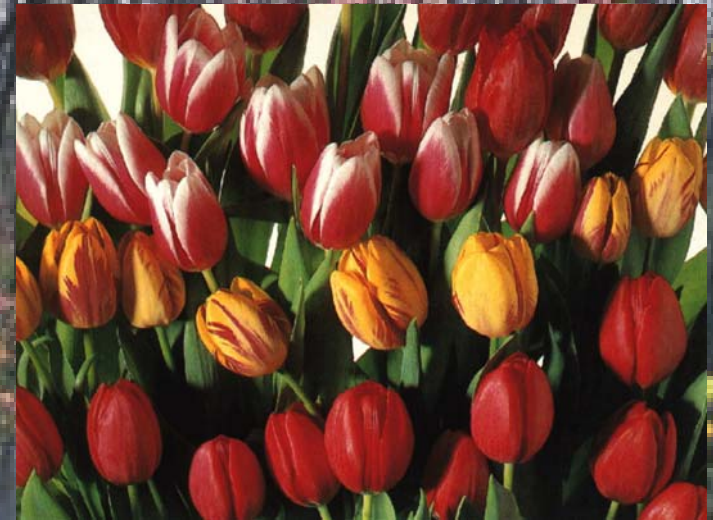

In the little house the starling dwells.



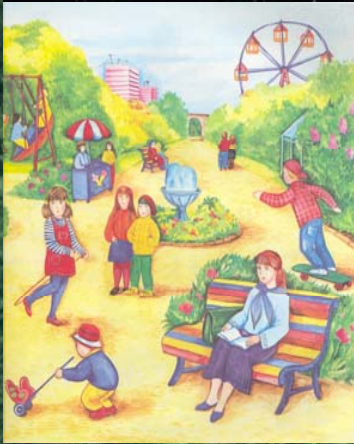


May

Fills the children's hands with posies.

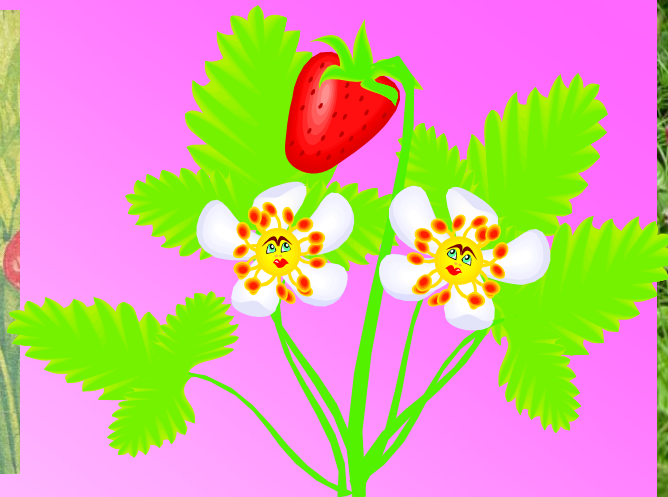




July

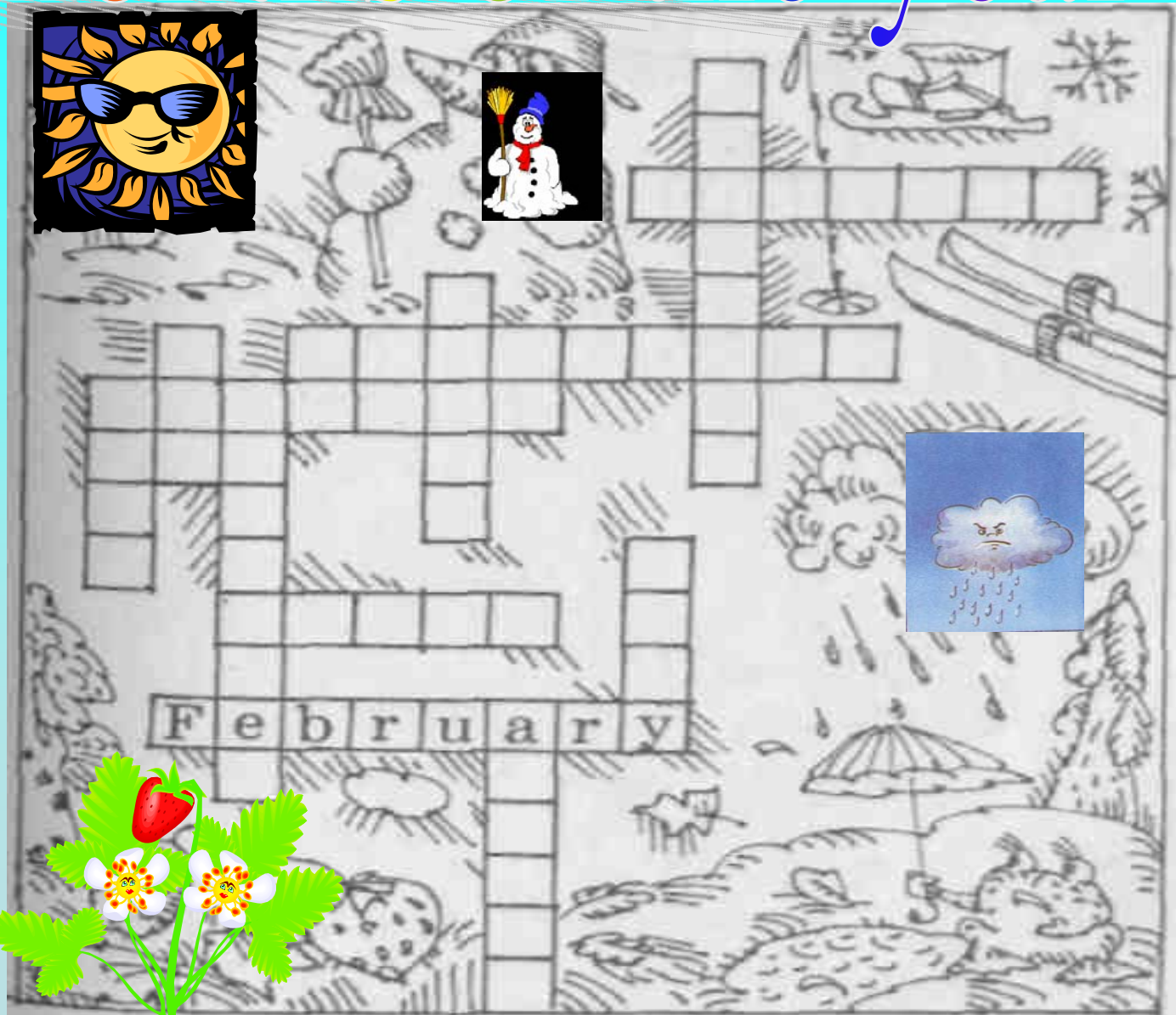
