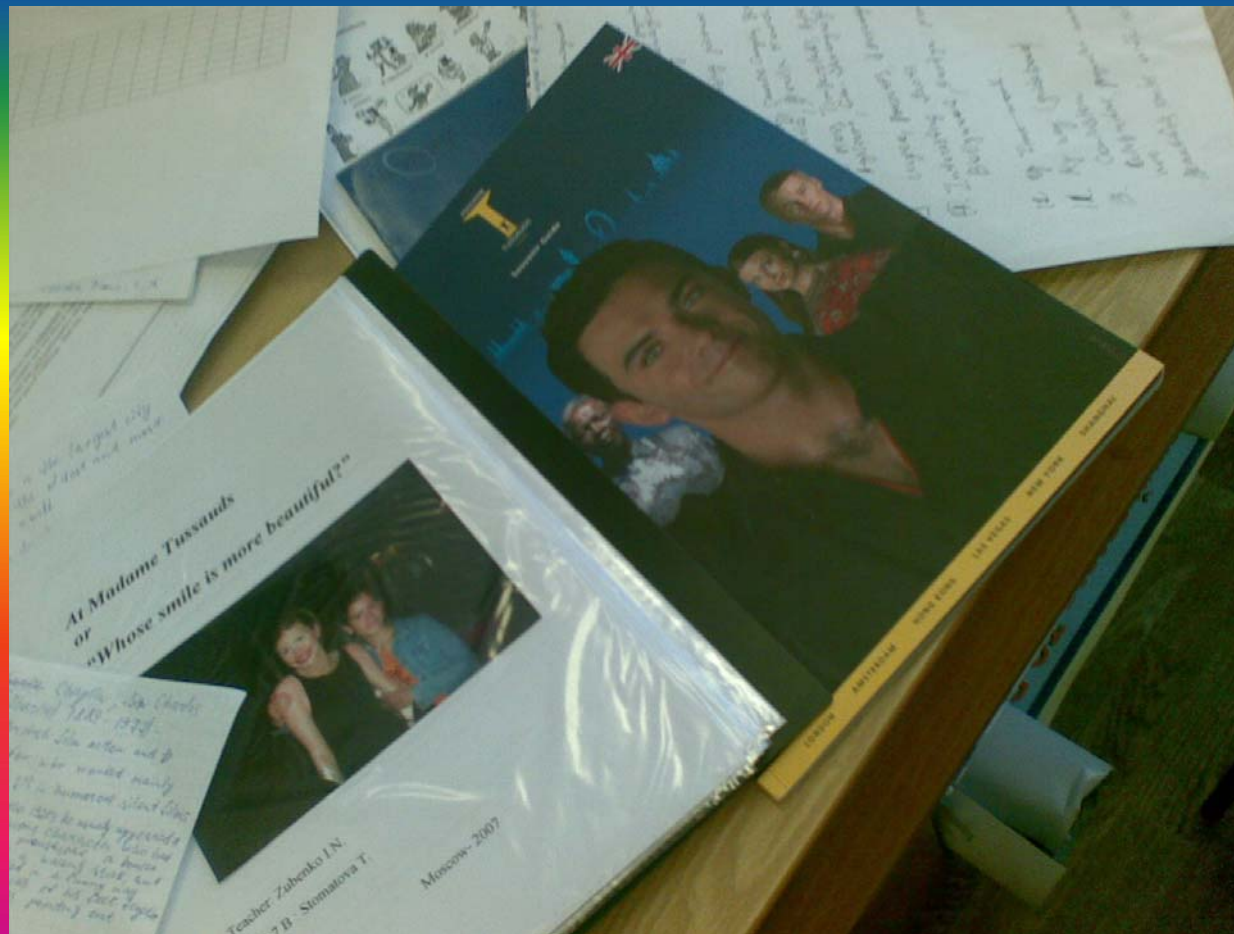

Hitchcock, Sir Alfred (1899-1980)

- A British film director who is considered to be one of the greatest and who made films in the UK and then in Hollywood, for almost 50 years. He made thrillers (films that tell exciting stories about crime and murder) such as ***The Thirty-Nine Steps***(1935), ***Psycho***(1960), and ***The Birds***(1963). He is famous for his use of suspense(=a feeling of fear and excitement that you have when you expect that something bad is going to happen) and for appearing for a very short time in each of his films as an unimportant character. People sometimes use the word 'Hitchcockian' to describe a story or situation in which there is a lot of suspense.

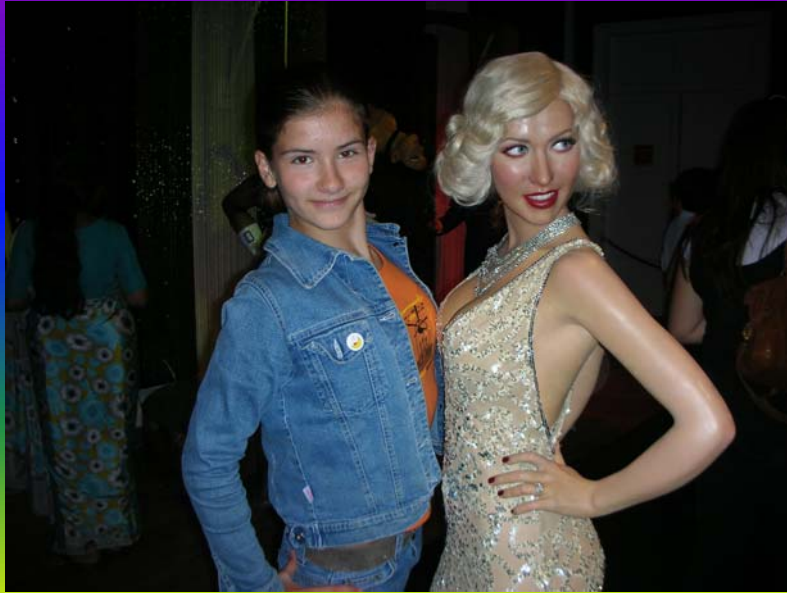

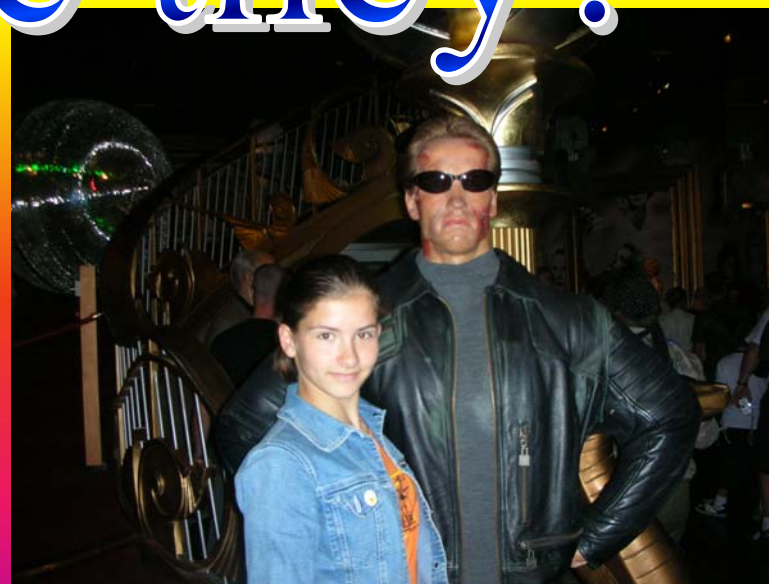
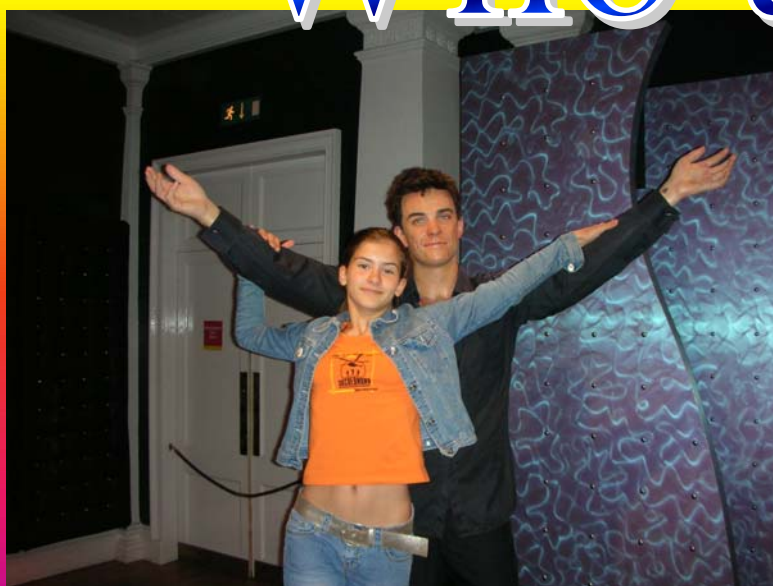
Book Online to see Christina with fellow divas, Britney Spears, Madonna, Beyonce and many other famous celebs at Madame Tussauds.

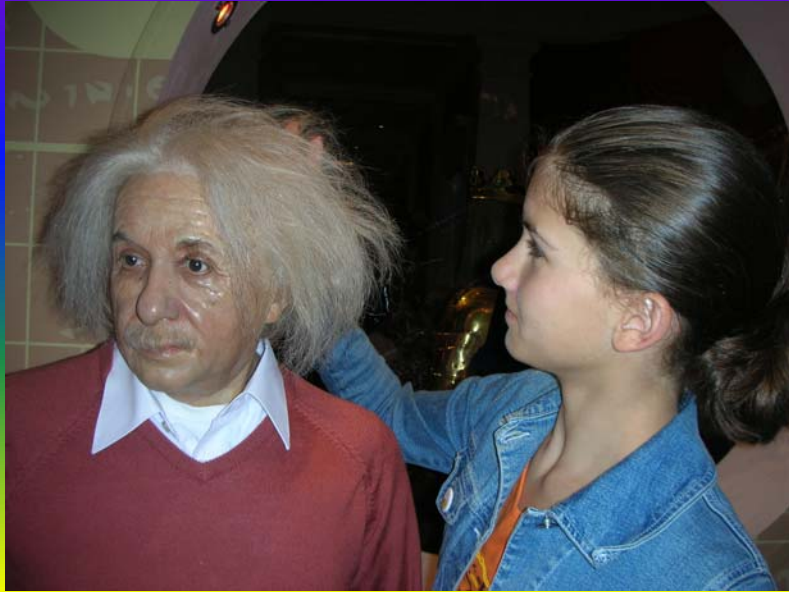
Get a taste of Bollywood at Madame Tussauds
