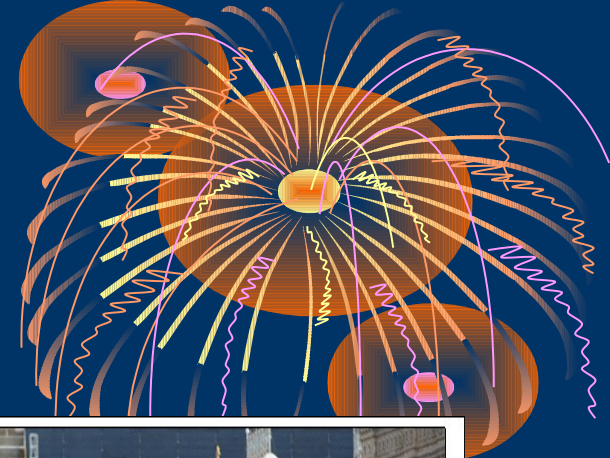
Project's problems are:

Our goals were right

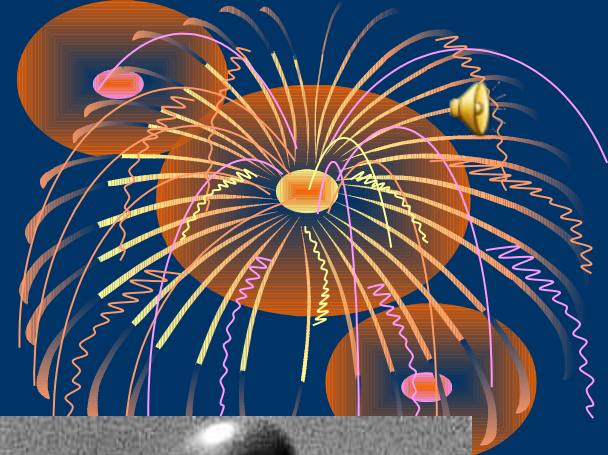
- **The Soviet people won the Great Patriotic War against a powerful enemy, Nazi Germany and its allies, because our people were fighting to liberate their own country.**



How it began...

June, 22. Some minutes past 4 a.m. without declaring war the Nazis troops invaded the Soviet territory. They had 4.6 millions of military men.

The group of Soviet troops numbered 2680 thousands of military men.....

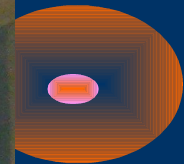
Letters from war

World War II brought a lot of suffering and hardship to thousands of people.



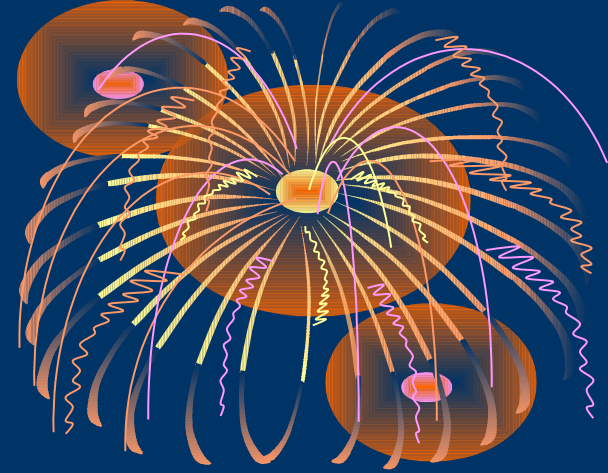
- **German bombers made terrifying night raids.**

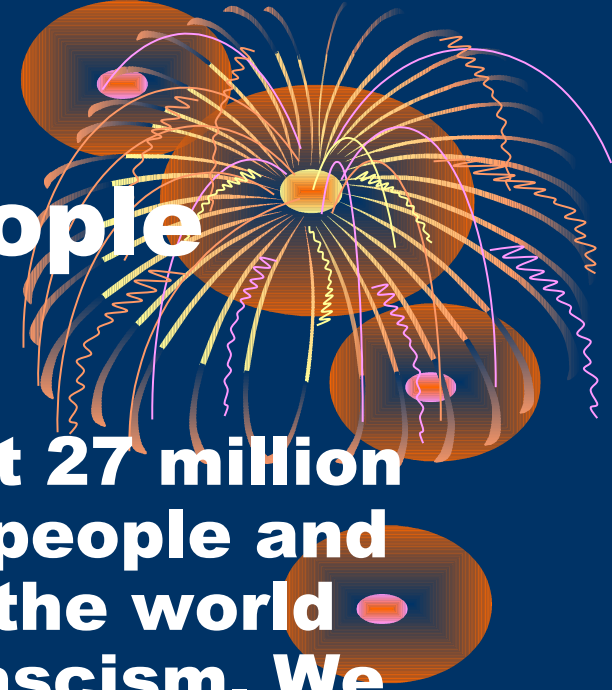

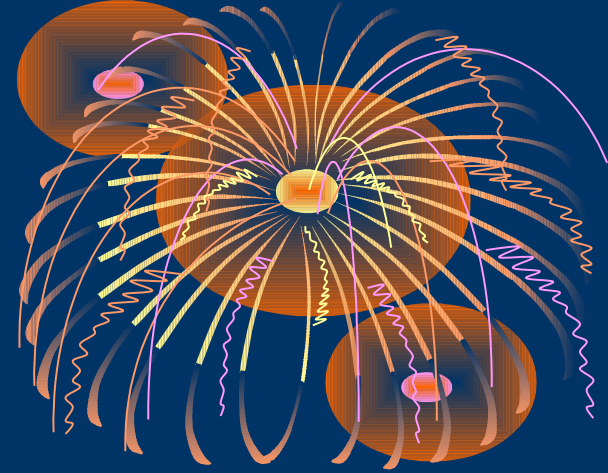


- We lost 27 million of our people and saved the world from fascism. We should never forget those who gave their lives for our Motherland.

“ It was dangerous living in a big city during the war. Cities were the target of enemy aircraft that flew over at night and dropped bombs.”

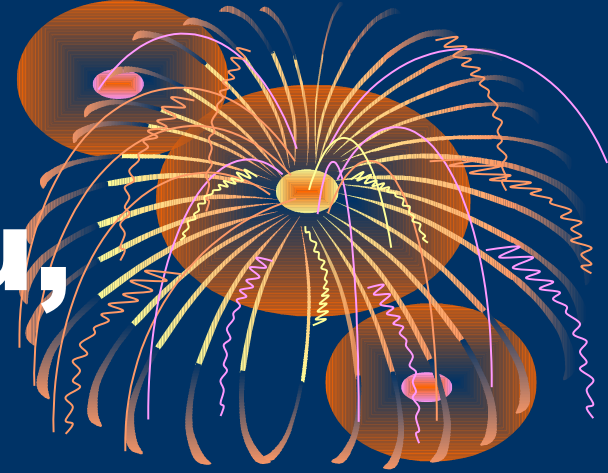

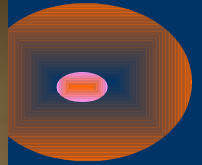
Lessons of courage

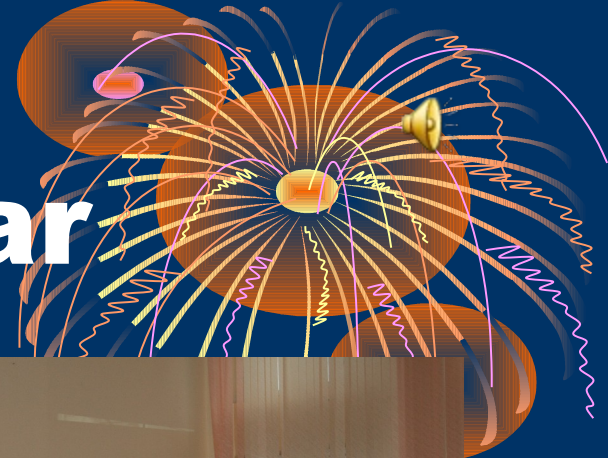

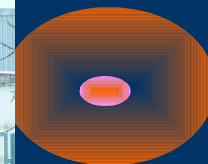
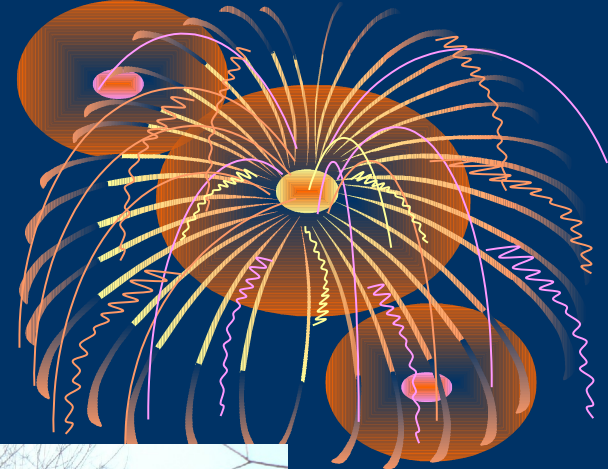
