















## The attitude of the pupils towards their pets









## The level of pupils' responsibility for their pet's life










## Parrot Grisha



# Animals in danger



## The problem

There is a serious habitat problem because...

- 1 After pollution or destruction, habitats take many years to grow again.
- 2 Pollution and destruction change the balance of nature. If one animal, bird or insect disappears, all the others suffer, too.

But the problem doesn't stop there. Habitats and animals are disappearing in Europe, South America, Africa, Asia.

## The solution

There is only one way to save wild animals and wild habitats- conservation.

That means...

- ⇒ Protecting animals in danger by law
- ⇒ Opening more national parks
- ⇒ Building fewer new roads
- ⇒ Planting more new forests
- ⇒ Cutting pollution

If this doesn't happen, many wild animals will soon have just one habitat-the zoo.

In 1981 there were 15,000 black rhinos in Africa. Today that number is 4,500.

In the 1970s there were 1.3 African elephants. Today there are under 85,000
